Call for European Health and Wellbeing SMEs to participate in 2014
EIT ICT Labs Activity



1.1 Grants / Expenses

Each selected SME is eligible to receive a Sub Grant of maximum 7,500 €. This includes both mobility and person-hour costs.

Mobility costs related to events organized by the Community will be covered within the grant to SMEs - including travel (flight, car, public transport) and accommodation. Such costs are reimbursed only upon the presentation of the relevant receipts. The grant can also cover costs of up to 2,000 € for person-hours spent in the Community activities.

The selected SME will have to enter into a so-called Sub Granting Agreement either with EIT ICT Labs, a Belgian international non-for-profit association having its registered office at 22, rue d' Arlon, 1050 Brussels, Belgium, or with a local EIT ICT Labs partner organisation that are awarding the Sub Grants, whereby (i) the conditions governing the use and reporting in connection with EIT funding and (ii) general legal conditions are laid down.

1.2 Selection Criteria

The company has on going business in the field of ICT and Health and Wellbeing.

The company has plans and resources to grow or expand their business in the near future to other parts of Europe and outside its country of origin.

SME is incorporated in or strongly connected to one of the seven Node countries: Finland, France, Germany, the Netherlands, Italy, Sweden, and UK.

The SME has introduced to the market an innovative ICT Health and Wellbeing technology/ service/ product with significant growth potential or a new application of an existing technology/ service/ product to the market.

The company has one or more customers in the local market.

The business idea of the company has significant international potential.

The company has strong technological background.

The company is preferably less than five years old.
